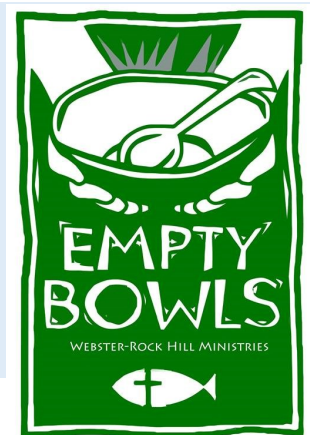

VOLUNTEER LAWYERS PROGRAM

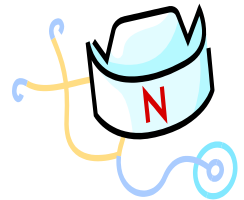
- NEED HELP WITH A LEGAL MATTER? -
